

(11) Large Sea Coral Tank

This is the largest artificially-lighted water tank in Japan. Tropical fishes show-off their radiant colors as they swim around the gently swaying coral reef.





When feeding time comes, seals come back to shore on their bellies, resembling wriggling stuffed toys!







The interior of the cool cave of shells is a canvas you can use to draw whatever you wish.




Sardine Ball Slider


